## Getting to Ferrara

The closest airport is Bologna Airport. Once landed, you can either get the Bus to Ferrara (via services easily accessible from the airport, such as the bus shuttle Bus&Fly that reaches the center of Ferrara directly) or by reaching the Bologna Train Station (by public transport bus from the airport) and then a 30-min/1h train to Ferrara.

Many buses leave from the train station directed towards the Department.
