Getting to Ferrara

The closest airport is Bologna Airport. Once landed, you can either get the Bus to Ferrara (via services easily accessible from the airport, such as the bus shuttle Bus&Fly that reaches the center of Ferrara directly) or by reaching the Bologna Train Station (by public transport bus from the airport) and then a 30-min/lh train to Ferrara.

Many buses leave from the train station directed towards the Department.

Getting to the Department of Economics and Management

The **Aula Magna** is located at the Department of Economics and Management in Via Voltapaletto, 11 (Ferrara). You can use Google Maps with this link to get directions to the Department. You can access the Aula Magna on the second floor (once you enter, up the stairs to your right).
