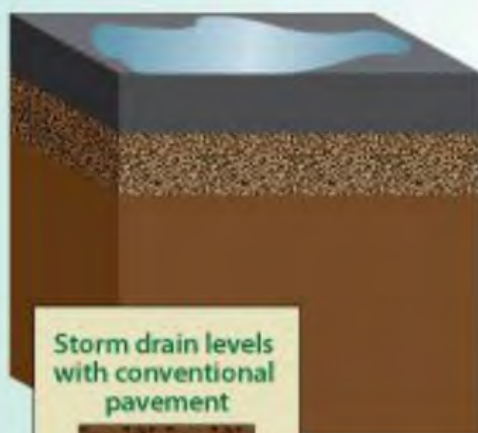

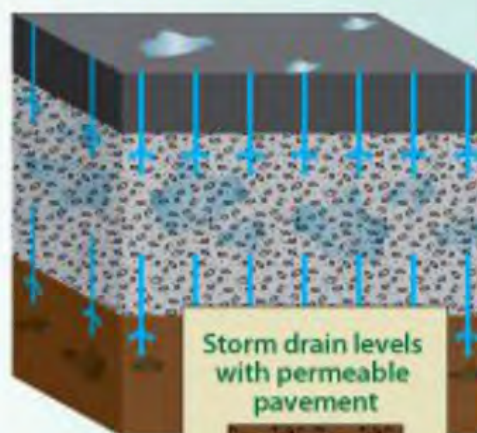

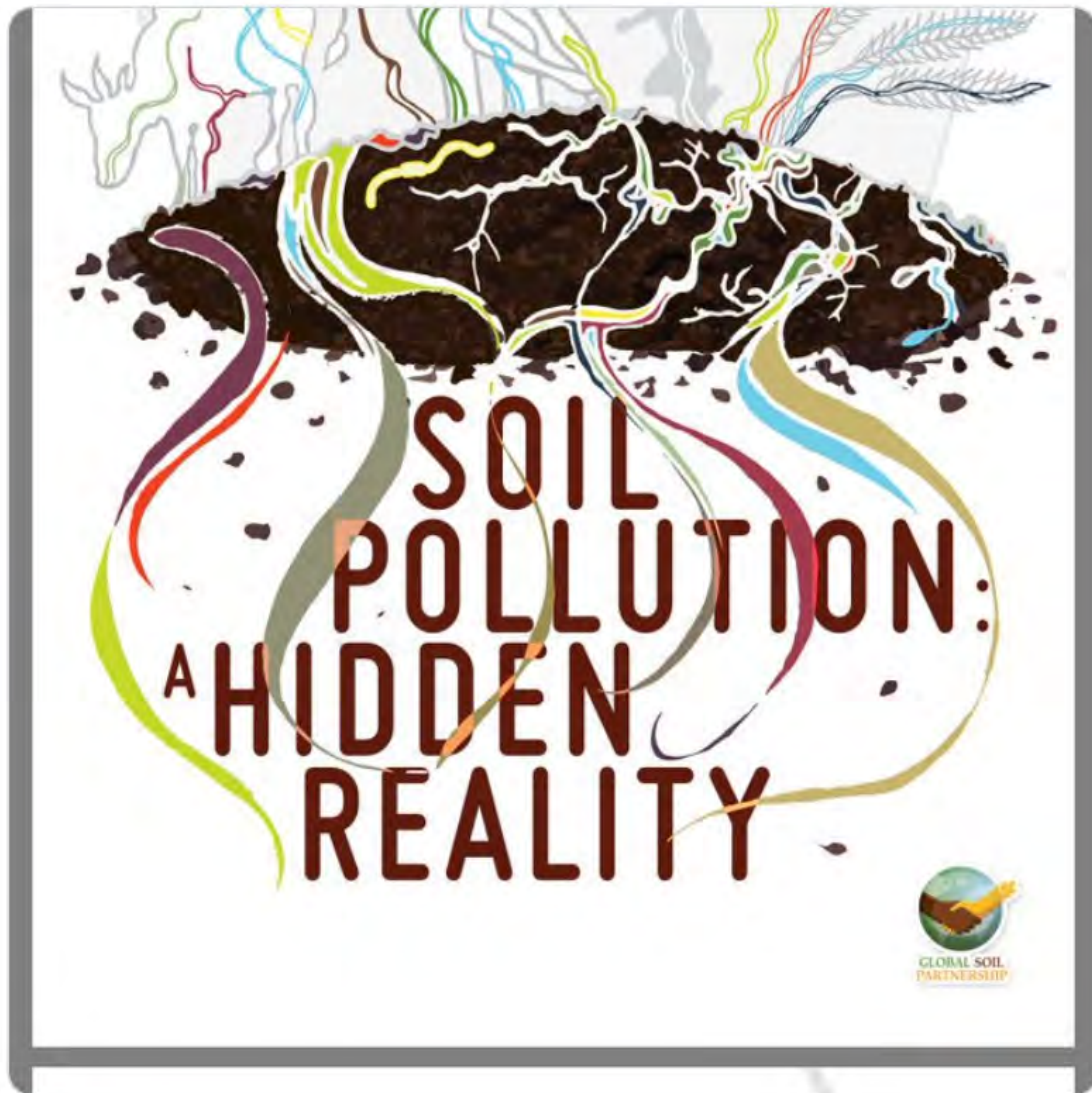


Storm drain levels

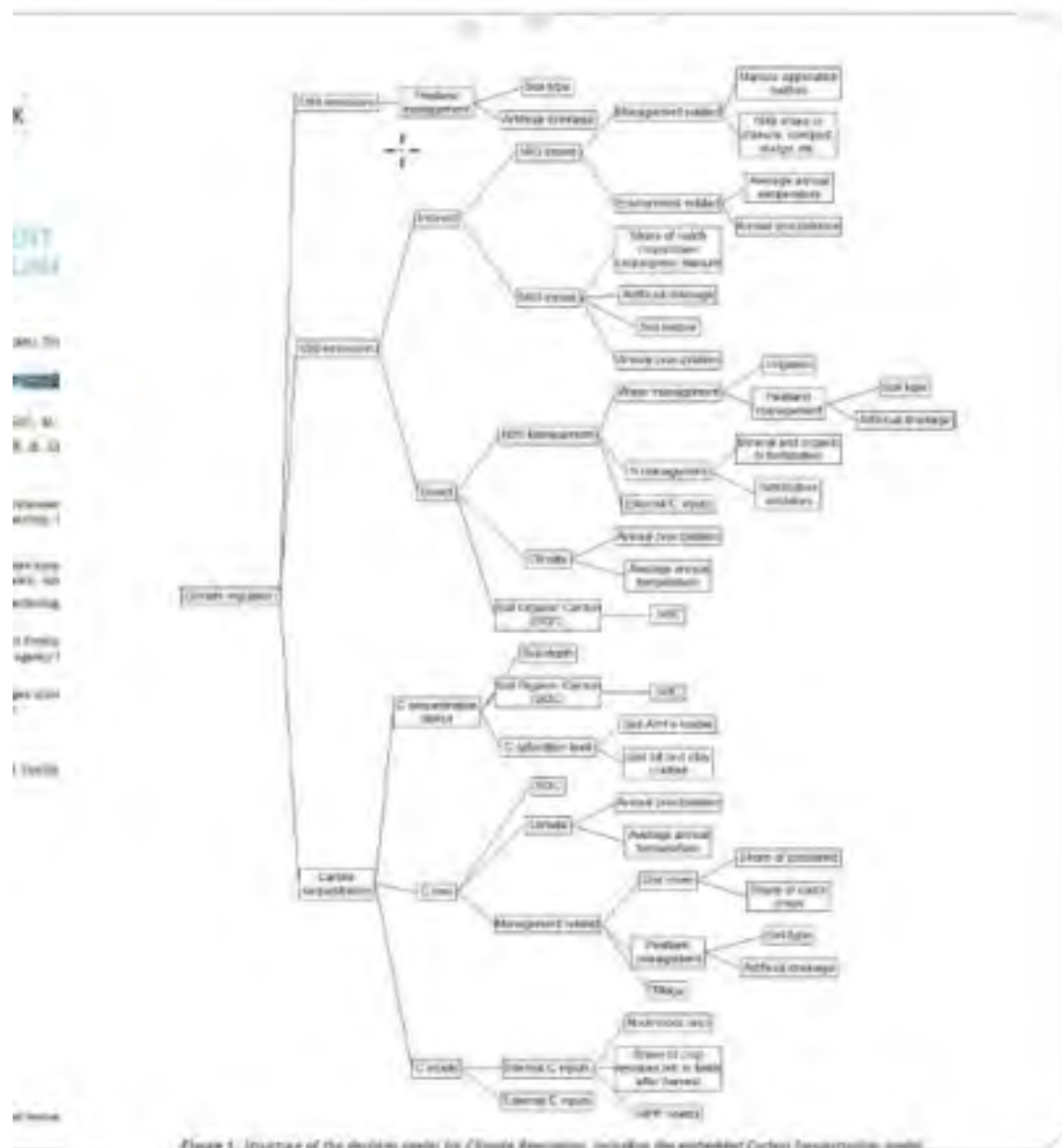

What we need to achieve

CREATE: plant woods and trees

Woodland covers less of Wales, compared with an average of 44% in Europe. Current planting rates are at an all-time low.

RESTORE: our damaged ancient woods

Since the 1930s, almost 40% of Wales' ancient woodland has been replanted with non-native species. The biodiversity of many of these woods will not thrive to decline without appropriate restoration.

In delivering a new nature and agriculture vision, we need to support the positive land management that delivers public benefits. The Woodland Trust believes that to achieve a fully resilient landscape, we must actively support the schemes that will protect and enhance the role of trees, wildlife and forests in ecosystems, as part of broader networks and as a component of sustainable food systems for both agriculture and forestry.

TREES OUTSIDE WOODS (TOWs)

Many trees are found singly, or in hedgerows, along roadsides, railways and watercourses, in parks and gardens, or are embedded in an agricultural landscape.

TREES ON FARMS

Agriforestry describes farming systems which choose to combine trees and shrubs with livestock, wooded pastures, or agricultural crops, in a land management approach that balances productive and protective functions of ecosystems.

PROTECT: our ancient woods and trees

Wales' rich heritage of ancient woodland, ancient trees, and ancient wood pasture and parkland are the last remaining, primary components of old growth woodland.

URBAN AND URBAN FRINGE

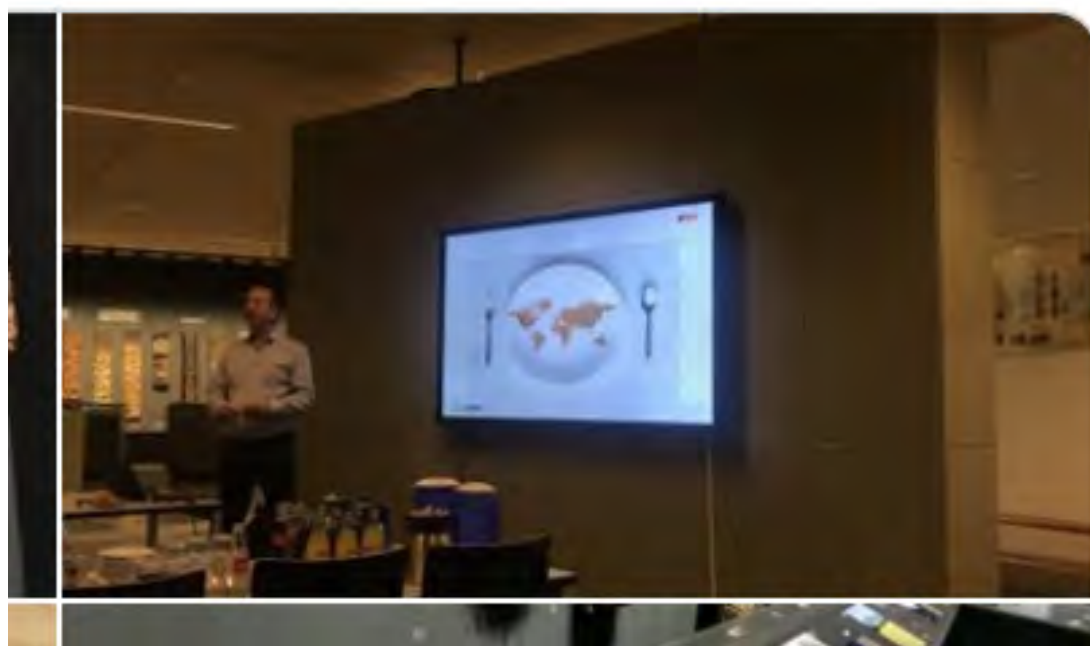
Evidence continues to grow of the significant health and wellbeing benefits of increasing tree cover in urban areas.

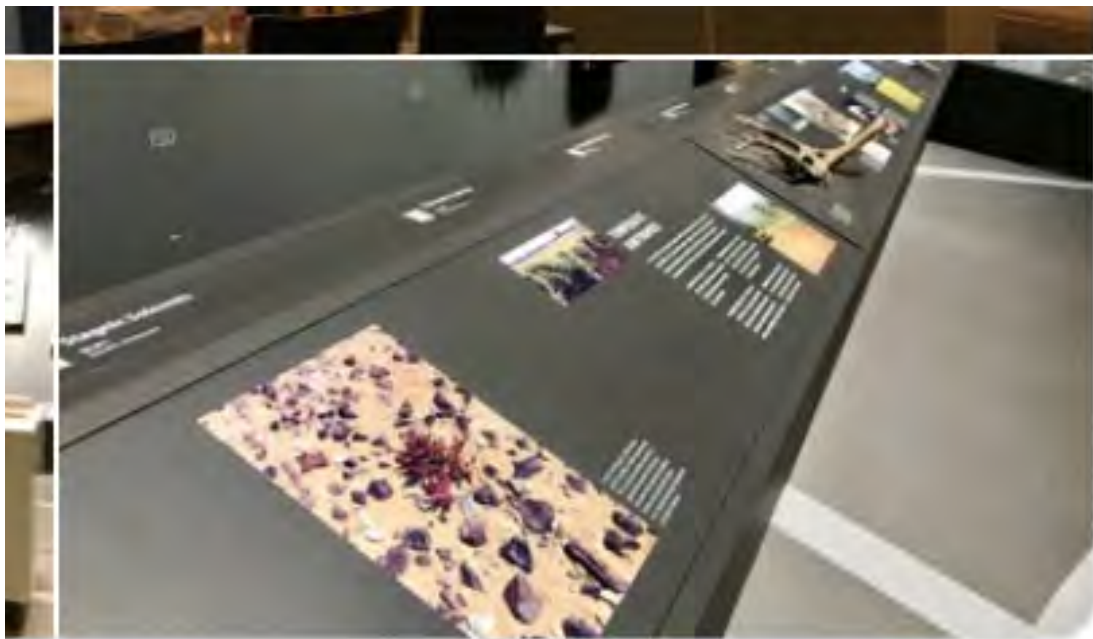
UPLANDS

Parts of Wales' upland landscapes are nationally and internationally important for their wildlife, and are valued as natural landscapes. Woodland and trees can help in preventing soil erosion, slowing water, storing carbon and providing wildlife habitats.
